DOPING VIOLATION

Colombian Inline Speed Skater **Anhilly Andrea Perez Moreno** receives
three (3) month sports ban

The International Federation of Roller Sports (FIRS) today acknowledged the decision of the Colombian Disciplinary Commission to impose a three (3) month ban on inline speed skating competitor Anhilly Andrea Perez Moreno for the presence and use of methylhexaneamine.

The prohibited substance was detected in a sample collected in competition from Ms Anhilly Andrea Perez Moreno at the 2010 World inline speed skating championships in Guame on 28th October 2010.

Ms Perez Moreno's ban means she is ineligible to participate, as an athlete or support person, in any sport that has adopted the World Anti-doping code until 9th July 2011.

The results obtained by Ms Perez Moreno at the 2010 World Speed Skating Championship are also disqualified and any medals, points and prizes awarded to her are forfeited.

Methylhexaneamine is classed as a stimulant on the World Anti-doping Agency's Prohibited List and is prohibited in competition.

Generally stimulants act directly on the central nervous system to speed up parts of the brain and the body. They can increase alertness and reduce fatigue in athletes.
